Background :

Once known to be The Old Hill Street Police Station, it now serves as the headquarters of Ministry of Information, Communications and the Arts (MICA). It's a 6-storey building erected and built in 1934 and was redeveloped and refurbished in 2000. MICA building is comprised of assembly rooms about 150 ft long and 80 ft wide and 48 units of offices.

CBM provides 24 x 7 remote monitoring with on-site security deployment services.

This 74-year old property offers an Atrium for commercial spaces, art galleries and houses other Government arms. First level is being used for art galleries, 5 levels are office areas and 1 level for car park with 251 lots.
